## RESOLUTION 2010-3

### A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ODESSA TO ADOPT THE NEW CASTLE COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL ALL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, as amended, requires that local governments develop and adopt natural hazard mitigation plans in order to receive pre- and post disaster assistance, and it is permissible by 44 CFR Part 201 that local municipalities may adopt the County mitigation plan as their jurisdiction's mitigation plan, and;

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent of the Town Council to fulfill its obligation and become eligible to receive Federal and State assistance in the event of a declared disaster affecting the Town of Odessa, and;

**WHEREAS**, New Castle County has developed and adopted a Multi-Jurisdictional All Hazard Mitigation Plan with input from the municipalities located within New Castle County through the County Hazard Mitigation Advisory Committee, public meetings and a contractor hired to perform updates to the plan. The Plan describes many of the natural hazards that may be encountered within the County, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Odessa has developed a separate set of Hazard Mitigation Strategies that are appropriate for our municipality.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town of Odessa does hereby adopt the New Castle County Multi-Jurisdictional All Hazard Mitigation Plan, adopted by the County Council on January 18, 2010, as the official All Hazard Mitigation Plan for the Town of Odessa.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Town staff shall update and revise the Town's portion as needed.
