DeIDOT Traffic Alert: Crossroad pipe replacement will require the closure of Old State Road

Middletown -- Traffic Information: The Delaware Department of Transportation (DeIDOT) announces to motorists that the removal and replacement of a crossroad pipe will require the closure of Old State Road. The replacement of the pipe will improve drainage.

Times and Dates: 7 AM on Monday, July 19 until 6 PM on Friday, July 23, 2021, pending weather.

Location: Old State Road between US 13 and Taylors Bridge Road, near Middletown.

At all times residents will have access to their homes but may need to take the posted detour route.

Detour Routes:

Traffic traveling southbound on Route 299 / Main Street will turn right at the intersection of Route 299 and US 13 south. Traffic will continue traveling south on US 13 until the intersection of Old State Road and US 13. At the intersection, traffic will turn left onto Old State Road.

Traffic traveling northbound on US13 will continue straight past the intersection of US 13 and Old State Road. At the intersection of Route 299 and US 13, traffic will turn right onto Old State Road.

Traffic traveling northbound on Taylors Bridge Road will turn left at the intersection of Taylors Bridge Road and Old State Road. Traffic will continue straight, turning right at the intersection of Old State Road and US 13. At the intersection of Route 299 and US 13, traffic will turn right onto Old State Road.

Traffic traveling westbound on Thomas Landing Road will turn right onto Taylors Bridge Road and then turn left at the intersection of Taylors Bridge Road and Old State Road. Traffic will continue straight, turning right at the intersection of Old State Road and US 13. At the intersection of Route 299 and US 13, traffic will turn right onto Old State Road.

Traffic traveling westbound on Old Corbitt Road will turn right onto Old State Road and then left onto US 13 southbound. Traffic will continue traveling south on US 13 until the intersection of Old State Road and US 13. At the intersection, traffic will turn left onto Old State Road.

Detour signage will be posted for motorists.
