- a. University of Delaware Energy Audit
 - The University of Delaware performed an audit here at town hall to determine how we can reduce expenses by reducing our energy consumption and upgrading to LED Fixtures. Interior storm windows have already been installed. The town has capital improvement funds available to pay for the upgrades. An estimate was provided by Masten Electric to perform the recommended lighting upgrades, attached hereto as Attachment D (1 page estimate)
