- c. Trees Meeting was 4-11-23 (Arbor Day Celebration, Inventory & Mapping, Outreach, Pruning Workshop, Grants)
 - Arbor Day Celebration was canceled due to rain. A certificate for John Goodier's tulip
 poplar tree will be presented to him at a later date. The Town of Odessa's application
 has been accepted and we are now once again a Tree City USA.

VII. Old Business

- a. Focus Group Update
 - Mayor Smith stated that on the advice of the town solicitor he wanted to make clear that a focus group related to the Osbourne Street Re-Subdivision cannot be endorsed by Town Council. He further stated that they aren't a committee of the Town and will be treated like any other citizens, meaning they will not be given any special treatment or time to report back to Town Council. They will get the same time that other members of the public get during the public comments section to make comments. As individual citizens they can provide their opinions, but the Planning Commission and Town Council have final authority.

b. Memorial Park Update

- The (3) hazardous trees are tentatively scheduled to be removed on Wednesday, May 3rd, 2023. Matt from RD Collins stated that they would like to try and complete the remaining open items in one visit. If it looks like it will take more than a couple weeks for the playground parts to come in, then they will make a separate trip to lay down the mulch.
- c. Old Academy Update
 - Flag pole lights have been installed. Electrical upgrades have been performed. The front door handle has been repaired. Smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors have been installed.
 - Outstanding items are: exit sign, exterior lights, downstairs bathroom remodel
- d. Pothole repair Park Alley
 - Austin and Bednash performed the repair on 4/19/23. Total cost of the repair was \$7,791.00.
